- The revenue received from successful outcomes is shared with Members.

HISTORICAL ECONOMIC IMPACT 2015-2021

Thirty-seven (37) ADEN Participants completed the Ticket to Work Program and off SSA cash benefits for more than three years.

Individuals who received Social Security disability benefits and chose to receive services from the American Dream Employment Network, earned more than \$20.7 Million in wages!

These wages contribute an estimated \$2.4 Million to the federal tax base, while saving more than an estimated \$2.6 Million from the SSA trust fund.

ADEN has a Partnership Plus agreement with 10 State
vocational rehabilitation agencies:
AR, CT, FL, GA, IA, ID, MD, VA, WA, WI

PAYMENTS for SERVICES

81% of current ADEN Members have received one or more EN payments.

EN Payment Types: 42% are Milestones and 58% are Outcomes. (The beneficiary is not receiving a SSA cash benefit when an Outcome payment is received.)

The average annual payment amount per ADEN Member, who receive payments, is \$32,129 (Range is \$1,019-\$157,059).
